9:30am Worship. This Sunday marks the beginning of our worship series on Dismantling the Doctrine of Discovery. Assembly recently joined a coalition of Anabaptist groups and congregations committed to the cause of Dismantling the Doctrine of Discovery: a historic and ongoing legal/philosophical framework that gave Christian governments moral and legal rights to invade and seize Indigenous lands and dominate Indigenous Peoples.
