Psalm 139:13 For it was you [God] who formed my inward parts; you knit me together in my mother's womb.

John 1:14 And the Word became flesh and lived among us, and we have seen his glory, the glory as of a father's only son, full of grace and truth.



Throughout much of Christian history, the physical body and the spiritual soul were held in opposition. The "desires of the flesh" and the "desires of the spirit" were pitted against each other in a battle between heaven and hell. However, while some have lived healthy, full lives by this teaching, many others have been hurt by it. The denial of the sexual aspect of being has caused much shame for many. What did God intend when creating human beings in physical bodies?
