

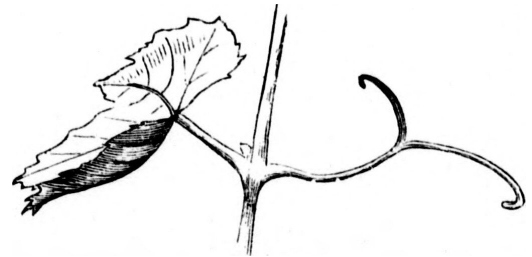

Summer worship 2019: Transition & Transformation

Theme verse: Ecclesiastes 3:1 “There is a time for everything, and season for every activity under the heavens.”

Assembly is in the midst of transition. We moved into our new worship space on Pentecost Sunday (June 9) and we are finally experiencing worship and congregational life in a space we have been anticipating for a long time. How is Assembly being transformed during this transition time? How are we, as Assembly members and attenders being transformed? And more broadly, how is our faith formed and transformed by life experiences of transition, some life-giving, and some full of grief, challenge and sorrow? The Psalms can free us to voice those big feelings and help us pay attention to how the Holy Spirit is moving in the midst of change. For some, God can feel most present during times of transition.

There is no summer Sunday School for children, and no Second Hour, so we will have ample time for singing, sharing, storytelling, and fellowship. We will worship at Oxbow County Park on July 7 at 10 a.m. and have a potluck picnic afterward.
