1 Assembly Mennonite Church: Charting Our Path Ahead

3 Worship

- 4 Worship Committee's current plan is to continue pre-recorded Zoom worship through August 2. On
- 5 August 9 we will have an in-person, physically distanced and safely masked baptism service in the church
- 6 parking lot. From August 16- September 27 we will meet in multiple pre-assigned outdoor neighborhood
- 7 <u>house-church cluster groups</u> for worship. Each week there will also be a Zoom option for those choosing
- 8 to physically distance or if weather is inclement. Each group will receive an order of worship and a script
- 9 for participants. These are intended to be participatory, intergenerational services based on the Shine
- 10 Sunday School curriculum. After that, we will likely gather remotely in live Zoom services with some adult
- 11 elective options.

12 Christian Education

- 13 There will not be traditional children's Sunday school during the next several months, and therefore we
- 14 have not recruited teachers for this time period. Instead, the Christian Education committee is
- 15 collaborating with Worship Committee to plan various elements of worship, including some that utilize
- 16 the Shine Sunday school curriculum. The JYF gathers monthly on Zoom or in person, and we have some
- 17 plans for how the K-5 age cohorts might connect periodically, depending how the school year unfolds.
- 18 And if we can do it safely, we'll have the annual fall garden party, Lantern festival, and Advent spiral.

19 Small Groups

- 20 During the pandemic, many small groups have been meeting more regularly via Zoom, and some are
- 21 starting to gather outside. In keeping with our goal of fostering a healthy small group system and enabling
- 22 participants to build relationships across the congregation, we will hold our annual Small Group Shuffle
- 23 beginning late summer. This is a time to join a new small group. If you have interest in a group with a
- 24 particular focus, let Karl Shelly know what that is. And look for announcements beginning in August.

25 **MYF**

- 26 Despite the challenges of these times, the MYF plans to continue meeting on Sunday mornings, outside
- and physically distanced on blankets, and via zoom when necessary. We share "highs and lows" and often
- have a discussion topic for the day. We also have occasional special events, while keeping safety a priority.
- 29 It is difficult to say at this point if/when/how some of the usual MYF activities will take place (live-in, drop-
- ins, winter camp, etc). But we want to continue to foster MYF as an important place for our high-
- 31 schoolers to find faith community. We are open to any creative suggestions others may have.

32 Congregational Meetings

- 33 Leadership Group will be thinking creatively about how we can hold future congregational meetings in a
- 34 safe and accessible manner during the ongoing pandemic.
